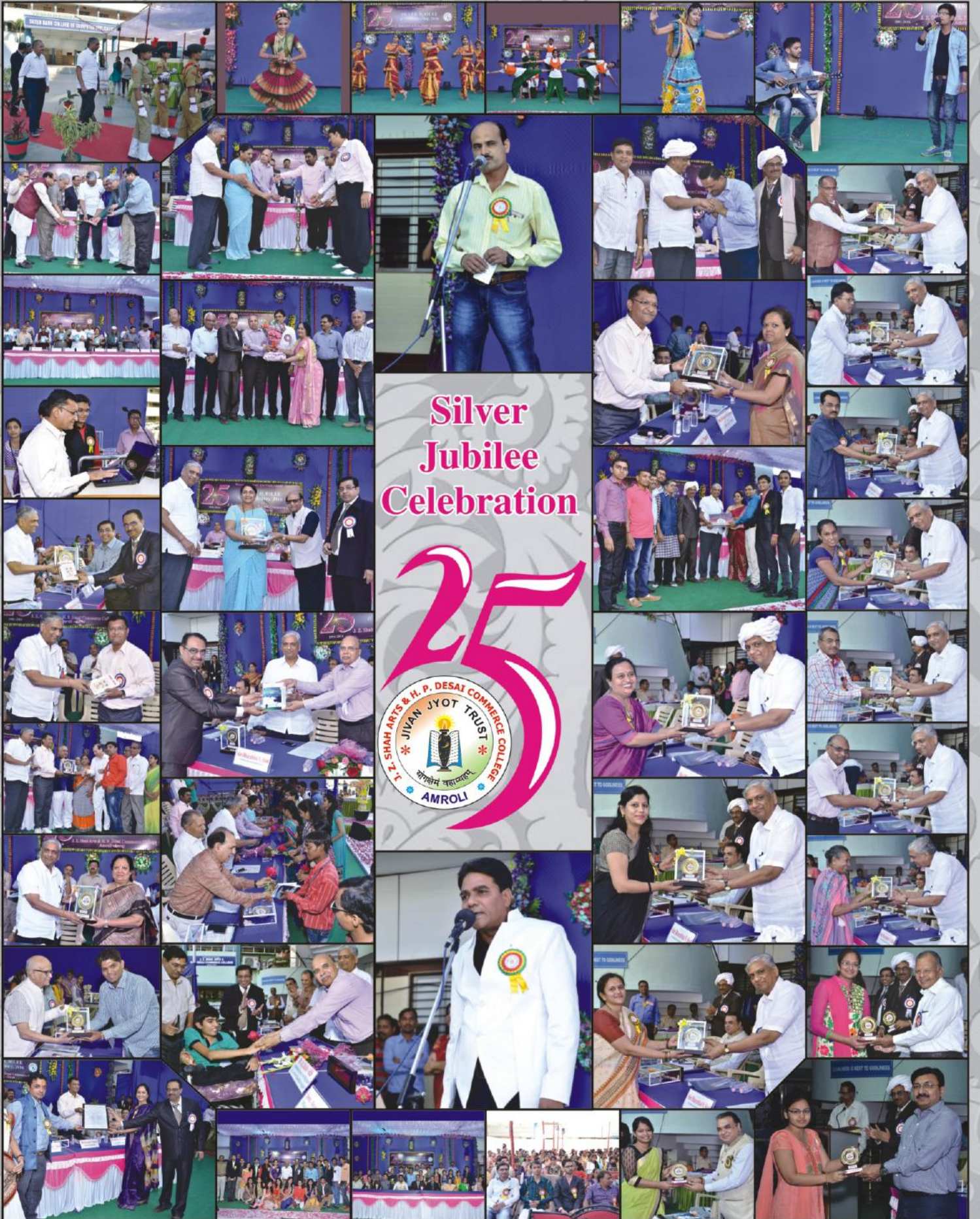

"Pragyan" was launched in the first term of the academic year 2015-16 to commemorate the Silver Jubilee Year of the college. Amroli, a place where the college is situated, is actually on the outskirts of Surat city and the population which resides in this place is generally from a very humble background. The parents send their children to government municipal schools and they have no proper grooming at home because of which it was felt that a learner studying for example in fifth grade was infact not possessing the required aptitude.
