Q-2 On 1-4-18 Milan and Hinal entered into joint venture to buy and sale Toys, they agreed to share profit and loss in the ratio of 3:2. (14)

On 1-5-18 Hinal purchased some Toys at Rs. 52 each and sent 360 Toys to Milan. He paid Rs. 5,550 for freight and insurance. In transit 37 Toys were damaged and the insurance company paid Rs.375. on 16-6-18 Milan made a remittance of Rs.10,575 to Hinal.

On 16-6-18 Milan purchased some Toys at Rs. 55 each and sent 150 Toys to Hinal, incurring Rs.2250 as freight and insurance.

On 15-7-18 damaged Toys were takenover by Milan for personal purpose price of 25 each and distributed the remaining damaged Toys free of cost .

On 16-8-18 both the partners sold 623 and 690 Toys respectively at Rs. 60 each. On 31-8-18 the venture was closed and the account were settled by bank draft. From the above information prepare in the books of Milan:

OR

Venus Brothers consigned goods 600 Laptop to Shiv on 1-4-2016. The invoice price of Laptop was Rs. 16,000 each. Invoice price was fixed by adding 25% profit on cost price. Venus Brothers paid Rs.16, 000 for rent Rs. 50,000 for freight and Rs. 80,000 for insurance.

Venus Brothers drew on Shiv a four months bill of Rs. 2, 50,000 which Shiv accepted and returned. Venus Brothers discounted it by 12% after two months. On the way 30 Laptop destroyed by fire. The insurance company accepted the claim for Rs.2,70,000.

Shiv sold 350 set for cash at Rs. 18,000 per set. 100 set were sold to Rudra on credit at Rs.18, 500 per set and 50 set were sold at Rs. 16,000 each to Tanisha on the recommendation and responsibility of Venus Brothers.

Shiv paid by way of octroi Rs.2, 50,210 for taking the delivery and Rs.25, 000 by way of sales expenditure.

As Rudra was unable to pay Rs.8, 220 the amount was written off as bad debt. Tanisha was declared defaulter and only 80% amount was recovered from him.

Shiv is entitled to get 5% commission and 2% del credere commission on credit sales. Shiv deducted amount due to him and sent a bank draft for the remaining amount.
