### **Students Satisfactory Survey (2019-20)**

Out of 1326 students we found that....

- 70% of the students fill this form for the first time.
  - Majority students are from bachelor program.
  - 97% of the students are from commerce.
1. 1259 students says that more than 70% of syllabus covered in the class.
  2. Majority of students are satisfied with the teacher's preparation for the classes.
  3. 72% of students were believes that communication of teachers is very effective. While 18% of students were says sometimes it is effective.
  4. 47% students says that the teacher's approach to teaching is excellent while 35% says it is good and other 16% believes it is good.
  5. 916 students says that the internal evaluation process done always fairly by teachers. 27% of them believes it is usually fair by teachers.
  6. 87% of students says that their assignment performance is discussed with them every time by teachers.
  7. Majority of students believes that the institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange and field visit opportunities for them.
  8. 92% of students says that the teaching and mentoring process in the institution facilitates them in cognitive, social and emotional growth.
  9. 62% of students strongly agree on that the institution provides them the multiple opportunities to learn and grow while 32% of students are agree on it.
  10. 70% of students says that teachers every time inform them about their expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes and other 24% believes that teachers usually inform this with them.
  11. 96% students says that their mentor does a necessary follow-up with them on an assigned task.

12. 71% of students says that teachers every time illustrate the concepts through examples and applications. 24% believes that teachers usually did this with them.
13. 76% of students believes that the teachers identify their strengths and encourage them with providing right level of challenges.
14. 91% of students says that teachers are able to identify their weaknesses and help them to overcome on it.
15. 57% of students were strongly agree while 37% of students were agree on that the institution makes effort to engage them in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.
16. 93% of students says that the institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.
17. 59% of students were strongly agree while 36% of students were agree on that teachers encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities.
18. 93% of students believes that the efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employ ability skills to make them ready for the world of work.
19. 92% of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.
20. 64% of students were strongly agree while 31% of students were agree on that the overall quality of teaching-learning process in the institute is very good.
21. They also suggested that arrange more education tours, cultural activities should done more, improve canteen facility, inovation activity should be done in twice in a year, more certificate course should be there, recreation room for boys, to arrange some free periods in schedule.
