#### 3. From the Principal's Desk

The year 2013 was a year of happenings and establishing standards of quality which engineered minds to think and evaluate performances. It was a year of NAAC Re-accreditation and got – "B" Grade with 2.74 CGPA which ushered in a lot of self-confidence and faith that many more milestones can be achieved. The institute witnessed a change in the attitude, participative management, academic leadership and a team spirit par excellence. For this year of 2014 the first step was to initiate an Institute Development Plan and materialize it within the XII Plan period till 2017, Goals and targets are set and the emphasis is to achieve these targets within the stipulated time and take the institute towards becoming a centre of excellence. In the wake of NAAC Re-accreditation the focus in 2013 was on highlighting the activities but in 2014 the institute plans to take a step forward towards vocationalisation of Higher Education and introduce short term courses which can enhance the employability of the learners.

The college won the Best Support Institute for providing the infrastructure for NCC camp. It also got Grade I in Academic and Administrative Audit carried Out by Higher Education Commissionerate of Gujarat on 3rd May, 2013 and declared the results on 12th September, 2013. The college scored 856.5 out of 1000 and with that it became the best college of Surat city. Now the college officially is rated as amongst the top five colleges which are affiliated to Veer Narmad South Gujarat University, Surat. Institute also set up a Commerce Lab, the one of its kind INFLIBNET & DELNET facility was yet again extended to all the students of the college. The hosting of twenty one Inter College competitions, Registration for Post-Matric Scholarship Policy for Minorities under the Online Management System, SCOPE-DELI. Training for all students, SCOPE exam, UPSC, GPSC regular training classes remained the highlight of the year. For the first time the Students Council organized a college Fest-INNOVISION - 2014 which brought to fore the administrative talent of the students.

As the nation voiced and grieved the death of Damini and heroic figure Nelson Mandela, it also applauded the victorious feat of Mary Kom and almost deluged in emotions when Sachin Tendulkar made his final announcement, celebrated the medal win at the Olympics, raced to cheer youths assertiveness against a 'chalta hai ' attitude and saw the most popular elections with maximum participation and AAM Aadmi gaining ground, the institute also took pride in the achievements of the students at the state & the national level. Various competitions and activities held brought forth the spirit and enthusiasm of the upcoming

With the college winning the Rotary Round Town Trophy for collecting the highest number of blood bags amongst the colleges in Swat eleventh time in a row ,it has yet again proved that accepting challenges and championing causes is important for creating social excellence. The planned activities of IQAC in particular and other committees, it became possible to complete the herculean task of Reaccreditation smoothly and enhance the infrastructure. The best part was a transformation of a simple complex to well furnished AC auditorium with a seating capacity of 500. Regular courses in 'DELL & SCOPE could lead to an improvement in the proficiency in the use of English language. NCC & NSS helped create zeal in the students for Improvement. Seminars, workshops, Career Guidance programs, Campus Interviews and Mock entrance tests helped in realizing the vision of the institute.



Publication of Books & Research papers, Research guidance, invitation as resource persons, presentations and participation in various workshops and STC courses occupied the interest of the teachers. The institute also hosted a one day national conference and created a platform for the Commerce teachers to discuss the burning issues. Awarding of the Doctoral degree to one faculty member, sanctioning of a Research Project of one and publication of books by two faculty members remained the highlights. It is time now for the institute to collaborate with stakeholders and create Public Private partnership and Institute-Industry Linkage to provide a platform for the students to become entrepreneurs and become job creators rather than job seekers. #### 4. An insight

In the rear 1991 came into existence the much acclaimed college of Surat city - J. Z Shah Arts and H. P. Desai Commerce College, Amroli which is a grant-in aid college affiliated to Veer Narmad South Gujarat University and was accredited by NAAC with 8 grade (CGPA 2.27) in 2008 and reaccredited in February, 2014 with 'B grade (2.74 CGPA). It envisions attaining excellence of students in academic and other programmes and is dedicated towards inclusiveness and bringing the girls to the main stream and inculcate in the students the skills and values necessary to succeed in real life situations to make them responsible citizens.

A performance based preview into the achievements of college in 2013-14 gives an idea of how the college excelled in various areas won the Best Support Institute Award from NCC and was also given Grade I by higher Education Commissionerate of Gujarat in the Academic and Administrative audit conducted. The college started regular classes of UPSC & GPSC exams and also for NET/SET Along with this Commerce lab was also established. Moreover a well furnished auditorium was set up with a seating capacity of 500 Students. Even the Alumni Association was officially registered. The tradition of enrolling students in the N-List Programme for accessing E-resources of INFLIBNET & DELNET was further strengthened. For the smooth functioning of the administrative work ERP package e-Mahavidhyalya was installed.

The college again won the Rotary Round Town Trophy for collecting the highest number of blood bags amongst the colleges' of Surat city for Eleventh time in a raw. For the second time in the history of Amroli College a girl was selected as the General Secretary of the college. College lifted the trophy in Inter college Elocution Competition and in the Youth Festival students won the Best actor and best actress award and even in Poster making a student of the college went on to win the Third Prize. The college sports persons in all won almost 17prizes and 3 medals and Women Yoga teams became the Champions in Inter college Yoga competition. The college also hosted more than twenty inter- college competitions, District level competitions and the NSS unit and NCC cadets raised fund. NSS volunteers did a good social work and the NCC Cadets outshined in various camps with their gutsy performance. The highlight of the year was the NAAC reaccreditation Process. Along with this even the College Fest INNOVISION-2014 purely organized by the Students' Council caught fancy of one and all.

The teaching faculty carried on their academic pursuits. One faculty members won an award for NCC. 3 students of the faculty members were awarded the M.Phil. degree under their guidance .4 members did Faculty Development Program. In all 25 research papers and 5 books of the faculty were published. The faculty members presented in all 25 papers out of which 03 papers were presented in International conference & 21 in national conferences. Teachers participated in 31 seminars & workshops. 2 NSS officers completed training. Five faculty persons had the honour of being invited as resource persons. The college aims to tread on the path of success with a quest for quality and an unending desire for excellence.
