In the year 1991 came into existence the much acclaimed college of Surat city- J. Z. Shah Arts and H. P. Desai Commerce College; Amroli which is a grant-in-aid college affiliated to Veer Narmad South Gujarat University and was accredited by NAAC with 'B' grade (2.27 CGPA) in 2008 and re-accredited in February, 2014 with 'B' grade (2.74 CGPA). This is the year of **Silver Jubilee**, college is celebrating 25 years of long and enriching journey. Five students and one NSS program officer of the college attended NATIONAL NSS MAGA CAMP GUWAHATI, ASSAM for 12 days. One faculty also attended training for teachers Rajiv Gandhi Youth Foundation. The college sportsperson in all won almost 25 prizes and Women Yoga Team became 2nd time consequently Champion in Inter College Yoga competition. College also organized inters college Yogasan Competition. Along with these even the College Fest INNOVISION 2015 purely organized by the Students' council 2014-15 caught fancy of one and all.

The teaching faculty carried on their academic pursuits. One student of faculty member was awarded Ph. D. degree under her guidance. Two faculty members qualified for GUJARAT STATE ELIGIBILITY TEST (GSET) Oct- 2014 in the subject of Commerce. Two faculty members did faculty development program. In all 14 Research papers of the faculty members were published. The faculty members presented in all 14 papers out of which 7 papers were presented in International Conference & 4 in national conference and 3 papers in E-journals.
