



Program arrange on Environment:



A) Solid waste management:


The institution takes all measures required to ensure that the campus is free of plastic items and also other wastes that harm the environment. Every class rooms, offices, staff rooms, verandas, and libraries are provided with dustbins for dry wastage which are emptied every evening. Surat municipal corporation is already having 'door to door' waste collection method on regular bases. The dry collected from the dustbins is given in door to door garbage collection. Electric sanitary pad disposal machine is installed in the girls common washroom.

B) Liquid waste management:

- At our campus, we treat waste water through sedimentation. The sewage water from the entire campus is received through the underground pipelines.
- Waste water generated by Ro purifiers plant is reuse to flush the toilets and to clean parking

C) E-waste management:

- Storage facilities of E-Waste materials

Rain water harvesting structures and utilization in the campus:
